Description:

The New Hanover Township Environmental Advisory Board invites residents who are concerned about the environment in which we live to join us. The Environmental Advisory Board (EAB) was established in 1999 to assist your elected Board of Supervisors on matters concerning environmental planning, legislation and public education.

The mission of the EAB is to identify various environmental concerns impacting New Hanover Township, which include, but are not limited to water, air, land, noise and light pollution. Based on community needs and input, the EAB evaluates waste disposal and recycling programs, promotes the preservation of natural resources and educates the community regarding environmental matters. We also review all development plans and provide input to the Board of Supervisors regarding potential negative environmental impacts. By way of public education, the EAB publishes a semiannual newsletter which is mailed with the Harbinger. Additionally, the EAB participates in the annual Fall Frolic at the Community Park.

Shade Tree Committee meets with the EAB and is appointed by the Board of Supervisors and is delegated the authority of control of shade trees within the Township as may be allowed by authority of the Second Class Township Code including planting, removal, maintenance and protection of shade trees on public streets and highways.

The EAB meets on the third Tuesday of every month at 7:00 P.M. in the township building located at 2943 North Charlotte St. (Rt. 663). We invite you to join us at our monthly public meetings and help us keep New Hanover Township a great place to live.

Description:

New Hanover Township is a semi-rural residential community currently working to maintain its quality of life while experiencing significant residential and non-residential growth pressure. (From 2000 to 2005 there was a 20% population increase). The Township's first Open Space Plan was completed in 1999. The Open Space Task Force continues to modify an Open Space Plan 2005/2006. The plan establishes a framework for creating new publicly accessible open spaces that will increase the quality of life and provide additional active and passive recreational opportunities for Township residents. Maps related to open space can be viewed here. Other goals of the Task Force are to preserve undeveloped land parcels, protect the natural features that exist within the Township, coordinate projects with neighboring communities and non-profit agencies, and work with developers to design environments.
